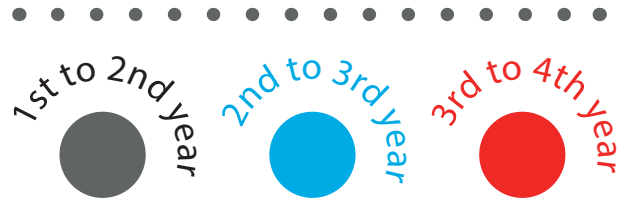

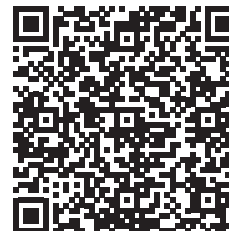
## DOs AND DON'Ts
